I am a large room with many statues and paintings. People come here to pray. WHAT AM I?

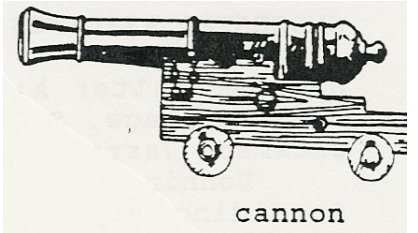
I am made of adobe bricks and have a domed top. I am used to bake bread. WHAT AM I?

I am made of metal and can make a loud sound. I am used to call people to church. WHAT AM I?

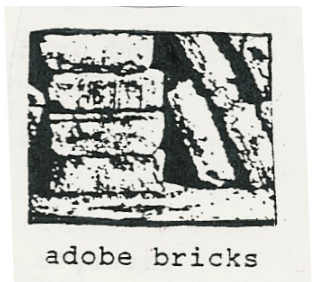
I am made of clay that is shaped like a small tunnel. I am baked so I will keep out the water when it rains. WHAT AM I?



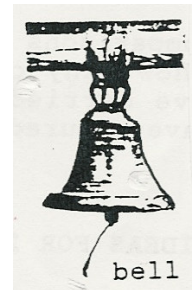

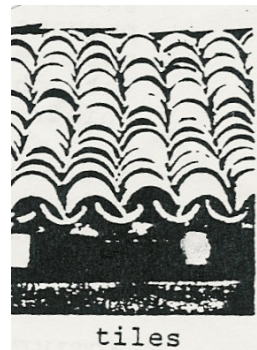

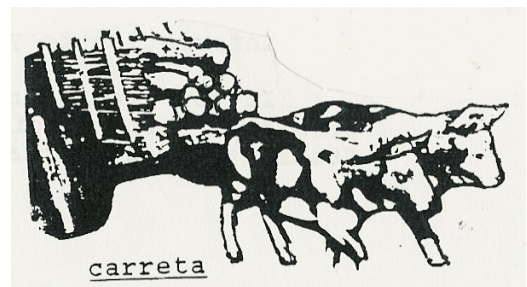
